ON 03/31/2021 AT 2124 HOURS, I WAS DISPATCHED TO [REDACTED] IN REFERENCE TO AN UNRESPONSIVE FEMALE. CENTRAL ADVISED THE COMPLAINANT, MS FELICITY ROLLINS, FOUND HER TENANT DEAD AND DECOMPOSING IN THE RESIDENCE.

UPON ARRIVAL, LT DILL (162) AND SGT PROBST (123) CLEARED THE RESIDENCE. THERE WAS A LARGE AMOUNT OF BLOOD ON THE FLOOR OF THE LIVING ROOM WITH TWO SEPARATE BLOOD TRAILS LEADING BOTH DIRECTIONS IN THE APARTMENT HALLWAY IN THE MASTER BEDROOM WAS BLOOD SPLATTER ON A MAJORITY OF THE WALLS AND BLOOD POOLED ON THE BED AND FOOT OF THE BED ON THE FLOOR. A PISTOL WAS OBSERVED LAYING ON THE MASTER BEDROOM BED. A HOLE WAS ALSO OBSERVED IN THE ROOF DIRECTLY ABOVE THE BED. ON THE OPPOSITE SIDE OF THE HALLWAY A DECOMPOSING FEMALE BODY (LATER IDENTIFIED AS MS CHRISTINA REVELS-GLICK) WAS OBSERVED LAYING ON THE GROUND. THERE WAS BLOOD ALSO OBSERVED IN THE GUEST BEDROOM ON A CHAIR, DESK, AND COMPUTER. MS REVELS-GLICK HAD AN EXIT WOUND FROM A BULLET ON HER FOREHEAD. WE SECURED THE RESIDENCE AND NOTIFIED THE ON CALL DETECTIVE, DET SMITH (144).

I SPOKE WITH MS ROLLINS WHO STATED SHE CAME TO THE RESIDENCE WITH HER BOYFRIEND, MR JAID BAILEY, AND FRIEND, MR GARETH WHITE, TO CHECK ON THE WELFARE OF HER TENANT, MS REVELS GLICK. MS ROLLINS STATED THE RENT WAS OVERDUE AND SHE HAD NOT HAD CONTACT WITH MS REVELS-GLICK SINCE THE END OF FEBRUARY. MS ROLLINS STATED SHE HAD MR BAILEY AND MR WHITE ENTER THE RESIDENCE FIRST AS THEY COULD SMELL SOMETHING DECOMPOSING. MS ROLLINS STATED MR BAILEY OBSERVED THE BODY OF MS REVELS-GLICK AND THEY LEFT THE RESIDENCE AND NOTIFIED LAW ENFORCEMENT.

DETECTIVE SMITH, DETECTIVE COLON, SCPL MITCHNER AND LT LAIRAMORE ARRIVED ON SCENE AND ASSUMED RESPONSIBILITY OF THE INVESTIGATION.

AN ENTRY LOG WAS MAINTAINED AND PROVIDED TO DETECTIVE SMITH. A SEARCH OF THE CAD REVEALED MS ROLLINS CALLED IN A WELFARE CHECK FOR MS REVELS-GLICK ON 03/19/2022 AND NEGATIVE CONTACT WAS MADE.

WE ATTEMPTED TO HAVE ANIMAL CONTROL TO COME OUT TO TAKE CONTROL OF THE DECEASED TWO CATS, BUT DUE TO THEIR PROTOCOL OF COMING OUT FOR ONLY SICK OR INJURED ANIMALS, THEY REFUSED.

MY DEPARTMENT ISSUED BODY CAMERA WAS ACTIVE FOR THE DURATION OF THIS CALL.

REASON FOR EXAMINATION:

Per investigation, the decedent was a [REDACTED] who was found in her residence with an apparent self-inflicted gunshot wound of the head and in an advanced state of decomposition during the morning hours on 4/1/22. She was last known alive on 3/19/22.

DATE, TIME, AND LOCATION OF EXAMINATION:

An external examination was performed on the body of CHRISTINA REVELS-GLIC at the Georgia Bureau of Investigation, Coastal Regional Medical Examiner's Office, in Pooler, Georgia on the 4th day of April 2022, commencing at 1200 hours, pursuant to the Georgia Death Investigation Act. The examination was performed by Joni B. Skipper, M.D.

EXTERNAL EXAMINATION:

The body is received within a black zippered transport bag in a supine position with the knees bent rightward. Tags affixed to the transport bag and left middle finger are inscribed with the decedent's name.

The body is wearing a black sports brassiere, black leggings, and a pair of black socks. Personal effects include a gray metal necklace with a pendant. The hair is secured by a yellow metal clip. All items are released with the body.

The body is that of an adult White female in an advanced state of decomposition which appears consistent with the reported age of [REDACTED]. The body measures 63" in length and weighs 84 pounds. Decomposition changes include mummification of the skin on the anterior body surfaces and green/red discoloration and slippage of the skin on the posterior body surfaces. Rigor mortis and livor mortis are absent. The body is cool to the touch. Maggots and pupae are present on the body surfaces and within the transport bag.

Injuries are described in "EVIDENCE OF ACUTE INJURY".

The scalp hair is black, straight, long, and sloughing from the scalp. The eye globes are collapsed due to decomposition. The ears, nose, and lips are present and distorted by decomposition. The mouth has natural dentition in good condition. The neck is without masses or unusual mobility. The chest and back are normally developed and stable to palpation. Bilateral breast implants are palpable. The abdomen is flat. The extremities are normally developed and symmetric. All digits are present. Artificial nails adhere to the fingernails. The toenails are polished pink. The external genitalia are those of an adult female.

IDENTIFYING MARKS AND SCARS:

No tattoos or distinct surgical scars are apparent.

EVIDENCE OF RECENT MEDICAL INTERVENTION:

No evidence of recent medical intervention is observed.

EVIDENCE OF ACUTE INJURY:

PERFORATING GUNSHOT WOUND OF THE HEAD: A gaping 1-1/2" entrance wound is on the chin located 7-1/2" below the top of the head and slightly right of the anterior midline. The margins of the wound are irregular, darkened, and softened due to decomposition, limiting examination for marginal abrasions and gunpowder residue.

The bullet perforates the skin, soft tissue of the floor of the mouth, hard palate, anterior cranial fossa, dura, brain, and frontal bone before exiting the forehead through a 1" stellate defect located 1-3/4" below the top of the head and slightly left of the anterior midline. Resultant injuries include tissue disruption along the wound path and fractures of the left aspect of the mandible, midline of the maxilla, and nasal bones.

In anatomic position, the wound path is upward and very slightly right to left.

POSTMORTEM IMAGING STUDIES:

Radiographs (anterior-posterior and lateral) of the body reveal multiple radiopaque fragments (small, non-recoverable) along the wound path through the head.

OTHER PROCEDURES:

1. Documentary photographs are taken.
2. Skeletal muscle is submitted to the toxicology laboratory at the Georgia Bureau of Investigation.
3. A bloodstain card is retained at the Georgia Bureau of Investigation.
4. Identification is confirmed by comparison of antemortem and postmortem dental radiographs.

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS:

1. Perforating gunshot wound of the head:
 - a. Entrance: Chin slightly right of midline
 - b. Range: Indeterminate (evaluation limited by decomposition)
 - c. Injuries: Skin, floor of the mouth, hard palate, base of the skull, dura, brain, calvaria
 - d. Exit: Forehead slightly left of midline
 - e. Trajectory: Upward and very slightly right to left
2. Advanced decomposition with postmortem insect activity
3. Identification confirmed by dental comparison

OPINION:

In light of the investigative information provided and the examination findings, it is my opinion that the decedent died as the result of a gunshot wound of the head. Furthermore, the manner of death is certified as suicide.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

Gunshot wound of the head

MANNER OF DEATH:

Suicide

Only those items discussed in the results above were analyzed for this report. The above represents the interpretations/opinions of the undersigned analyst. Unless noted above, evidence analyzed in this report will be returned to the submitting agency. Biological evidence (body fluids and tissues) and proof determination evidence will be destroyed after one year.
